

GUIDELINES OF COMMUNICATION

1. Both JCI and ICC-World Chambers Federation (WCF) write to their respective constituencies seeking examples and case studies of any partnerships between JCI chapters, Chambers of Commerce and/or ICC National Committees.
2. Upload joint activities on a webpage branded JCI ICC-WCF
3. Have a letter from ICC addressed to ICC-WCF (Chambers of Commerce and/or National Committees) introducing the JCI National Organization when requested by JCI World Headquarters.
4. Have a JCI and WCF Directory with contact information. This directory is to be uploaded at the JCI and WCF website.
5. Sign a MoU between ICC-WCF (Chambers of Commerce and/or National Committees) and JCI National Organization covering, as a suggestion, the following points:
 - a. Offer such JCI programs as the JCI Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) programs for Small-Medium Enterprises (SMEs), JCI Best Business Plan Competition and JCI TOYP to ICC-WCF (Chambers of Commerce and/or National Committees).
 - b. Promote mutual membership amongst eligible members.
 - c. Provide JCI trainings to ICC-WCF (Chambers of Commerce and/or National Committees), when applicable.
 - d. Request that ICC-WCF support the establishment of JCI National Organization Secretariat be located within its premises.

Note: electronic copy of the MoU needs to be sent to JCI World Headquarters and ICC-WCF.
